BASIC INFO FOR LEADERS

- The cost for Super Summer is \$270.00 per person through June 4. After June 4, the cost increases to \$290.00 per person. Late registrations will be accepted only as space allows. Any additions after June 4 are considered late registrations. If your group space is full. please contact Beth Payne (bpayne@kncsb.org) with any late registration requests
- Registration includes lodging, meals, recreational activities, materials, and theme t-shirt. There are no additional required expenses but snack items and other sale items (such as shirts, stickers, books, etc.) will be available for purchase.
- All weeks of Super Summer take place at Webster Conference Center in Salina, Kansas
- Super Summer is open to all students who have completed the 6th Grade through those students who are graduating seniors in the spring of 2024.
- Only church groups can register for Super Summer. All individuals must register as part of a group. No individual registrations can be accepted.
- No infants or children may attend Super Summer.
- Sponsors must be at least 21 years of age to attend Super Summer. The suggested ratio is one sponsor for every 8-9 students. Make sure you have the appropriate number of sponsors for each gender.
- The church must have background checks on file for eah adult sponsor attending Super Summer.
- You will need a printed medical release for each student. If you do not already have these on file at your church, you can get one at supersummer.net. If you already have your church's own medical form, you do not need to use our form. You will keep the forms in your possesion throughout Super Summer.



SPONSOR REQUIREMENTS

All youth MUST be accompanied by an adult sponsor. The suggested ratio is one adult for every 8-9 youth. All sponsors must be 21 years of age or older. The church must have a background check on file for every adult attending Super Summer. Sponsors must be capable to provide supervision and care for the needs of students. Super Summer does not provide an on-site medical staff. Sponsors will be responsible for administering first aid and any prescription meds brought by students. We are encouraging every church to bring a First Aid Kit.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE AT SUPER SUMMER

- Registration is from 2:00-3:00 p.m. in the Multi-Purpose Commons. Early arrivals will not be registered until the registration set-up is complete.
- •Only adults are allowed in the registration area. Please ask all youth to remain outside.
- •After completing registration, please transport your youth to their assigned housing unit. Do not allow anyone to change housing assignments. If you see an empty bed when you move in, chances are almost 100% someone will arrive to occupy that bed in the near future.
- •After unloading and getting settled, youth and adults are free to participate in the recreational activities. At 4:15 p.m., there will be a sponsor orientation meeting, recreation will close at 5:00 p.m., and dinner is served at 5:30 p.m.
- Please park in designated parking areas. Do not park vehicles or trailers on the grass.

CHURCH GROUP MEETINGS

Each church will meet as a group twice a day, beginning Monday night. The meetings will last 45-60 minutes and the leadership of these meetings will be the responsibility of the sponsor in charge of your church group. Morning meetings will be Quiet Times (materials provided at camp) and evening times are more participatory.

K.P.

K.P. stands for Kitchen Patrol. Everyone does K.P.- students and sponsors. When you arrive at camp, you will receive your assignment. Every group is assigned to one meal. When you report for K.P., you will be given instructions and assignments (such as filling drinks, picking up trays, sweeping, scraping trays, etc.).



Prescription medication- needs to be in original containers

SUPER SUMMER GUIDELINES

- There will be no possession or use of tobacco, e-cigarettes, alcohol, and/or drugs except for the purpose of medication. Immediate expulsion may result from violation of this guideline.
- Electronic entertainment devices (such as iPads, video games, etc.) are not allowed.

B.I.A.S.T. GAMES

B.L.A.S.T. stands for "Bringing Leaders and Students Together". When you arrive at Super Summer, you will be assigned to one of four B.L.A.S.T. Teams. If a church group is large enough that it would constitute 50% or more of a team, your group will be divided among two or more of the B.L.A.S.T. teams. There is something fun that everyone can do regardless of the age or health limitations. The concept is to bring people together in a fun atmosphere and help them develop deeper relationships with those from their church, as well as others from different churches. It is wet, wild and low-skill fun recreation!

WATER GAMES are a significant part of the B.L.A.S.T. Games. Please bring appropriate clothing. Swimsuits, dark T-shirts, shorts and shoes that can be wet will be needed.

RECREATION/ CHALLENGE COURSE INFO
